## Time Table

Regular class work has been scheduled, Monday to Friday from 8.30 AM to 3.30 PM. Regular class work will be based on the academic calendar 2021.

## Holidays

All Kerala Government holidays approved by the Management are holidays for the college. Other holidays if any will be announced by the Management from time to time. However any working day lost on account of any Bandh, Hartal or the like will be compensated by an additional working day on a Saturday/holiday.

## Rules of general discipline

Students are to strictly follow the following:

- Class timings: 8.30 AM to 3.30 PM with a lunch break from 12.05 PM to 12.55 PM for Higher Semesters of CSE, ECE, EEE & ME and the lunch break from 11.15 AM to 12:05 PM for S1/S2, Higher semester of CE, BT & BCE, MCA & M.Tech students.
- The students should be inside the classroom before 8.30 AM.
- Students will not be permitted to leave the campus between 8.30 AM and 3.30 PM without the prior permission/sanction of the Director / Principal. If the students leave the campus without proper permission, the matter will be informed to the parents. If it is repeated a fine of Rs 1000 /- will be collected on intimation to the parents.
- Unauthorised absence from the classes will be taken seriously and disciplinary action will be taken. Sanction should be obtained from the HOD in advance for any absence. If the absence is more than 3 day's medical certificate should be produced. All medical leaves have to be sanctioned by the Director / Principal. Leave letter to be submitted on the day they come back to the college. No late leave will be considered.
- Students, who have no class, are not allowed to loiter around in the campus during class hours disturbing other classes. Abstaining from class "en-masse" is considered as a serious offence for which disciplinary actions will be taken.

- Silence should be maintained in library and computer labs. Library books should be handled with care. Rules pertaining to the issue of library books should be adhered to.
- As per the High Court Order mobile phones are banned inside the college campus. Strict disciplinary action, including confiscation of the mobile phone and a fine of Rs.1000/- will be imposed on students who violate the above rule.
- Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the college according to the directions of the AICTE and Government of India. Penal measures to those found guilty of ragging will extend up to immediate expulsion from the college.
- Students are expected to maintain a very high order of discipline. No effort shall be spared to conduct themselves at all times, at all places, and on all occasion in a manner worthy of students of a course which is to lead them to high responsibility in the future.
- Students are expected to adhere to the dress code prescribed by the institution while in campus. Boys should wear trousers with formal belts (only black / brown colours permitted) and insert shirts with half sleeves and their feet should be protected with socks and shoes. Jeans and T-shirts are not permitted. Girls should wear salwar kameez and dhuppatta. Girls should take care to tuck their hair. The ID card should be displayed whenever they are inside the campus. Strict disciplinary actions will be taken on the spot against those who violate the dress code. Any change from the dress code is permitted with the consent of the Director / Principal on special occasions.
- Every student shall provide himself/herself with the entire prescribed textbooks, drawing instruments and accessories and other such articles required for the classroom work.
- The college properties should be handled with maximum care and everything possible should be done to preserve the cleanliness, and tidiness of the building, furniture, library, buses and premises. Fine will be imposed for damages to equipment, furniture, building etc.
- The students are to attend all the activities organized by the college otherwise fine will be imposed.
- A number of additional programs in the form of Add-on courses, remedial classes, extramural lecture, study tour, industrial visit, finishing school, soft skill training etc are arranged for the development of the students. It is mandatory to all the eligible students to attend all these programs
- From the academic year 2021 the institution will be following 5 days week (Monday to Friday) timetable.

- 24 hours ambulance facility
- Infirmary with the service of a doctor at BT&BCE Department.
- Sick rooms are available in the EEE Department (Ladies 1<sup>st</sup> floor & Gents 2<sup>nd</sup> floor)
- 24 hours Internet facility both for day scholars and hostlers.
